**Description:** Kamuning is a small evergreen tree or large shrub, growing from 3 to 8 meters in height, having a very hard wood and producing white and fragrant flowers. It is widely used as an ornamental hedge but is also medicinal due to its anti-herpetic, anti-diarrheal, aromatic, refrigerant, tonic and stomachic properties.
